About Delhi

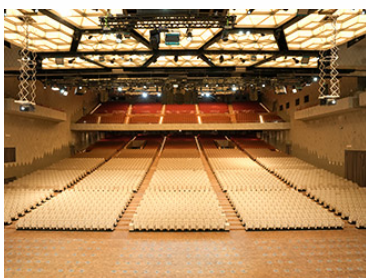

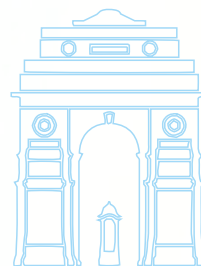
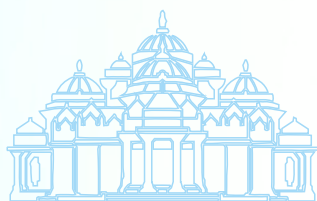
Red Fort's Lahori Gate

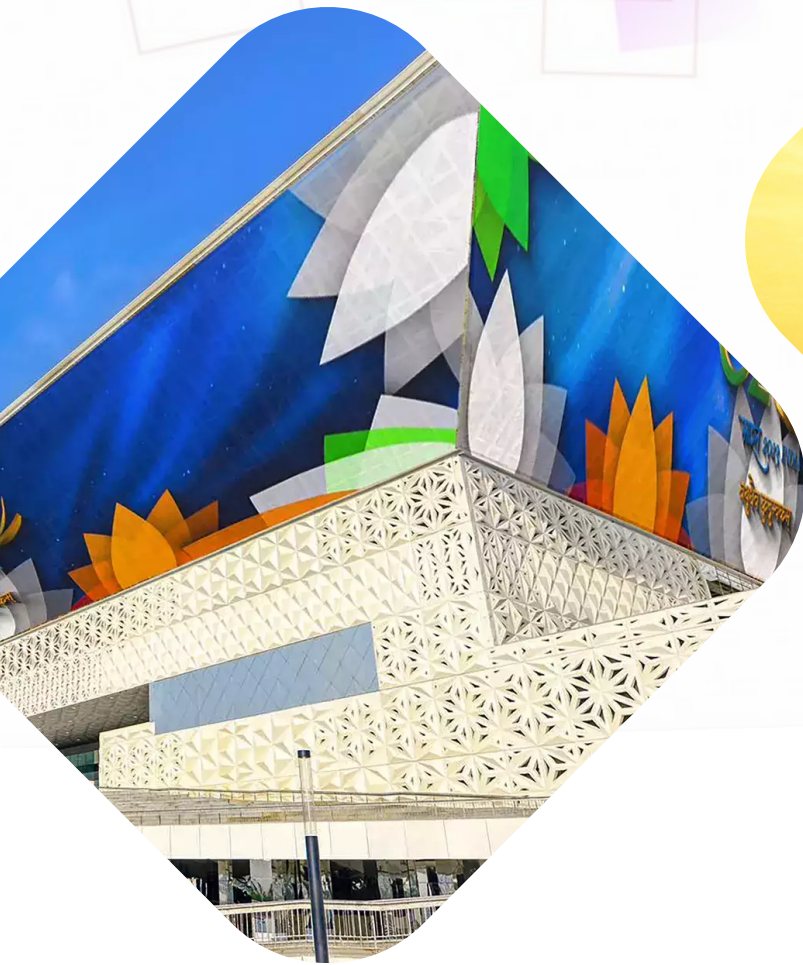
