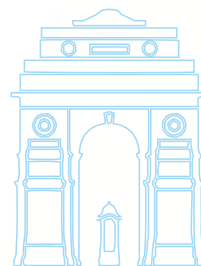
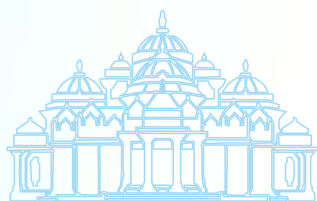
### Red Fort's Lahori Gate
